#### Event Site – Spot Levels

- The level at the Finish Line is assumed to be 0.000m. Three check-points should be taken in a line: inside lane one, in the centre of the track and outside the outer lane. Levels need to be provided at the start, and at the Finish Line on the straight.
- It is essential that reduced levels (not grades) be provided on each of the runways.
- The sign convention used by World Athletics for inclinations is that an upward inclination in the direction of running is positive.
